The Bridge exists to bring hope to those who have no hope, to see those who are marginalised being supported and valued and to see people set free from the limitations of life-controlling addictions.

The Bridge was started in 1999 by Oasis Church to serve disadvantaged members of our community. We run three supported accommodation houses in Birmingham, catering for both men and women recovering from drug and alcohol addictions. We provide support in their recovery right through to reengaging with employment or training and taking on their own home.

We offer a structured recovery programme including a weekly 'Twelve Step' principles group, one-to-one key working and group support. We also run a programme of therapeutic activities designed to build confidence and self-esteem and equip residents with skills for independent living and further personal development.
